### **BBC Scotland – migration to Pacific Quay and smaller projects**

BBC Scotland David worked as the move manager for a 1400 staff moves from their existing location in Glasgow to the new £180m BBC Scotland Headquarters at Pacific Quay Glasgow. Working in close association with BBC Management and Production staff and JCI FM team successfully completed the 18 phase relocation on time and on budget. Among a range of co-ordination activities, David's team undertook the management of an 80% reduction of existing filing in line with BBC Scotlands' new policies on data management.

When the moves were complete Harrow Green returned to complete the clearance of redundant furniture to be placed into the recycle project at Recycle Scotland.
